Thursday September 26th 8:30am-5:00pm USAF Museum (Transportation Included)

We will attend the Dedication Ceremony for the 7th Air Commando Squadron & 7th Special Operations Squadron Memorial Bench. You will also have time to visit the Museum galleries that represent military aviation history, boasting more than 360 aerospace vehicles and missiles on display -- many rare and one-of-a-kind -- along with thousands of historical items and powerful sensory exhibits that bring history to life and connect the Wright brothers' legacy with today's stealth and precision technology. The Museum's galleries are arranged in chronological order. The Early Years Gallery features airplanes and exhibits from the dawn of aviation through World War I. The Air Power Gallery focuses on World War II aviation, while the Modern Flight Gallery covers the Korean War and the Southeast Asia (Vietnam) conflict. The museum's newest buildings, the Eugene W. Kettering Cold War Gallery and the Missile and Space Gallery take visitors from the Soviet era to the cutting edge of space exploration. Lunch will be on your own at the museum café.

Friday September 27th 9:00am-5:00pm Carillon Park (Transportation Included)

Carillon Historical Park celebrates how Dayton, Ohio, changed the world. The Gem City is home to the airplane, the automobile self-starter, the cash register, the first internationally acclaimed African American poet, the National Football League's inaugural game, and so much more. With a hand-carved carousel, 4-D theatre, trains, slides, living history experiences, thousands of artifacts, extensive educational programming, and so much more. A briefing is planned for The 1905 Wright Flyer III: The only airplane designated a National Historic Landmark, the first practical flying machine, and what Orville considered the brothers' most important aircraft. Orville Wright gifted the airplane to the park". Lunch will be on your own at Carillon Park.

Saturday September 28th Noon-10:30pm Oktoberfest (Transportation Included)

Dayton Art Institute Oktoberfest, features live music, family activities, outstanding artisans, delicious food, a Weingarten and, of course, an amazing selection of more than 50 craft and international beers!
